- 1. All sheep to be unloaded and trailers off the field by 9.15am
- 2. All sections open to MV accredited and Non MV accredited sheep, which will be penned separately.
- 3. All sheep unloading in the MV section must share a copy of their MV accreditation certificate, prior to unloading.
- 4. Two completed movement forms (one on and one off) to be handed to the secretaries' tent on arrival. Completed off movement forms will be available for collection from 3pm in the secretaries' tent.
- 5. Judging will commence at 9.45am with the young shepherds' classes.
- 6. Breed classes will follow the young shepherds at approximately 10.30am.
- 7. Interbreed sheep will be judged on a points system by all the breed judges at approximately 1pm.
- 8. Trophy presentation to take place in the sheep pens immediately following the interbreed sheep championship.
- 9. All first prize winning sheep and their handlers are invited to take part in the grand parade around the main ring at 2pm (non MV sheep only).

Sheep must remain on the field until the conclusion of the grand parade at approximately 3pm. Failure to do so could result in prize money being forfeited.
